



Situated just two minutes' walk from Horsham train station, Winterton Square is ideal for both commuters and culture lovers alike, with regular services to central London taking just under an hour. For those going further afield, Gatwick airport is just 20 minutes away.

Horsham also enjoys excellent road links. The popular towns of Guildford and Crawley are both easily reached, while Brighton's nightlife and famous laines are just 23 miles away.


AT THE HEART OF IT ALL

WALKING DISTANCES FROM WINTERTON SQUARE*

The Forum 16 min 0.8 miles — 1600 steps

Bus station 15 min 0.8 miles — 1600 steps

East Street (eat & shop) 12 min - 0.6 miles - 1200 steps

Carfax (band stand) 10 min 0.5 miles – 1000 steps

The Pavilions 6 min 0.3 miles – 600 steps

Horsham train station 5 min 0.2 miles – 400 steps

Horsham Park (conservatory café) 5 min 0.2 miles – 400 steps

The Capitol theatre 6 min 0.3 miles – 600 steps

Swan Walk & West Street shops 11 min 0.6 miles - 1200 steps

The Causeway 11 min 0.6 miles – 1200 steps

Sainsbury's supermarket 15 min 0.8 miles – 1600 steps

Waitrose & John Lewis 17 min 0.9 miles – 1800 steps

* On the basis that a person of average height has a stride length of about 2.1 to 2.5 feet we can say that approximately 2,000 walking/jogging steps make up a mile. This means that 10,000 steps converts to around 5 miles, with average stride length.

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
A QUALITY FEEL

Our properties at Winterton Square are available to purchase through shared ownership. You buy a share of the value of the home and pay affordable rent on the remainder. Starting shares are available from as little as 25%. Over time and as your finances allow, you can increase your share to up to 100%...

Eligibility

To buy a home with us, please register with Help-to-Buy at www.helptobuyese. org.uk and check that you meet the shared ownership requirements. If you already own your home, or own a home under a shared ownership scheme, you can still apply for Weald Living shared ownership provided you are currently marketing or have already sold your home. You'll need to be at least 18 years old to be able to obtain a mortgage.

You will need approximately £5,000 to cover the costs of purchasing a home. These costs cover things like; the reservation fee, mortgage valuation fee, mortgage arrangement fees, solicitors' fees, removal costs and utility connection charges.

Affordability

Household income requirements will differ from development to development in line with factors such as current house prices and the share for sale. The general guidelines state that you must have a combined household income of less than £80,000 per year outside of London.
